



Nuckolls County Board Minutes



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NOVEMBER 23, 2015 PROCEEDINGS OF THE NUCKOLLS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Nuckolls County Board of Commissioners met Monday, November 23, 2015 in the Board Meeting Room at the Courthouse, Nelson, Nebraska, per recess of November 16, 2015. Christensen, Zikmund and Corman present for the meeting. The agenda of said meeting was remitted to board members in advance of the meeting and is posted in the County Clerk's office and on the County Website. Chairman Corman announced the 'Open Meetings Act Law' as posted in the Commissioners Board Meeting Room and handouts are available.

The board reconvened at 9:00 a.m. A motion was made by Christensen to approve the Agenda and the November 16, 2015 minutes. Seconded by Corman. Corman, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

Deb Larson presented the Aflac programs that are being offered to the Nuckolls County Employees should they choose to purchase a supplemental insurance.

Christensen shared with the Board that he felt the Agenda being released on Friday afternoon was not efficient time for the Board to review and research the agenda items before the Meeting. **A motion was made by Christensen for the all future Agendas to be posted at 4:00 p.m. on the Thursday before the meetings. Seconded by Zikmund. Corman, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

Warren, Highway Superintendent informed the board that he would be purchasing a truck for a rip rap truck project for \$10,000. Bridge # C006554625 on Road C will be closed till repaired. Bridge Project # C006504205P, the first bridge west of Bostwick qualifies for the use of Federal Grant Funds.

A motion was made by Corman to Accept the Bid from Rasmussen for \$3,260.00, to rewrap and secure sensors on piping in the boiler room. The previous wrap had been removed in the mold remediation process leaving the sensors exposed. Seconded by Christensen. Corman, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Zikmund for the Chairman to sign the 911 Agreement that was presented November 16, 2015 by the Nuckolls County Sheriff. Seconded by Christensen. Corman, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

County Attorney Sara Bockstadter approached the Board about introducing Formal Juvenile Diversion & MIP Diversion Programs in Nuckolls County. Bockstadter explained that she would supervise and work with the Hastings office to introduce these programs to Nuckolls County. **A motion was made by Zikmund to Introduce Formal Juvenile Diversion & MIP Diversion Programs to Nuckolls County. Seconded by Christensen. Corman, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

Bockstadter also expressed concern about the lack of security in the Courthouse. The discussion was tabled till Sheriff Baker could be present.

Chairman Corman recessed at 10:30 a.m. for Board of Equalization.
Chairman Corman reconvened at 10:37 a.m. in regular session.



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The board discussed concern about the communication they had been receiving about LB344. Zikmund will draft and send a letter on behalf of the board stating their concerns.

A discussion was held about the Nuckolls County employee's hours on the upcoming holidays. **A motion was made by Christensen for all Nuckolls County Departments to close at 12:00 p.m. on December 24, 2015 as well as December 31, 2015. Seconded by Zikmund. Corman, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

There being no further business the meeting was recessed at 11:07 a.m. until Monday December 7, 2015
